Healthcare

New Collaborations/Partnerships



Partnership between Ziauddin Hospital and KDSP:

As KDSP and its reach continue to grow, so do the healthcare needs of the expanding clientele registered with KDSP. This year KDSP had the privilege to collaborate with another one of Pakistan's biggest healthcare providers, Ziauddin Hospital. This partnership aims to cater to the healthcare needs of children with Down syndrome in the utmost efficient manner, one that proves to be highly sustainable and beneficial to both the organizations and our clients.

Success Stories

Hiba Habib, a 1.3-year-old girl with severe hearing loss, received funded hearing aids from KDSP, enabling her to hear a wide range of sounds and live a fulfilled life.

Muhammad Maaz, an 11.2-year-old boy with dental complications, received KDSP funding for his extensive treatment plan, including extractions, fillings, and fluoride application. He now enjoys improved communication and a comfortable daily life.

Mannat Mir, a 4.4-year-old girl, was admitted to AKUH with chest congestion and diagnosed with pneumonia. KDSP provided emotional and financial support during her three-day stay in intensive care. Mannat has fully recovered, participating in ECI therapies and thriving in good health.

Education

Events/Highlights

1. Annual Inclusive Education Training

21st - 28th January

The training was held in collaboration with the **Institute of Business Administration** (IBA). The 3-day training program included 6 interactive sessions, from understanding the learning profile of individuals with intellectual disabilities such as Down syndrome, **Autism and ADHD**, to learning how to incorporate academic modifications, developing individualized education plans, and managing behavior in a mainstream classroom setting.



2. EPEP World Down Syndrome Day Spring Festival

10th March

The EPEP students and their parents celebrated **World Down Syndrome Day** with a beautiful spring festival filled with flowers, activity stations, pictures and a quiz for the parents! The students also got to help make flower necklaces for their mothers!









21 students from our Early Preschool Experience Program (EPEP) Batch of 2023 completed a year of learning communication, language, fine and gross motor, cognition, play, socio-emotion and self-help skills. The batch dressed up in matching shirts and walked down a ramp with little graduation caps as their parents cheered in the audience. Our donors also joined this celebration with family and staff to see our graduates step into mainstream schools and continue their academic journey. Education for Life Batch I students also set up a pop-up canteen at the event which was loved by all our guests.

Early Childhood Intervention (ECI)

Parent Orientation Sessions

May – June 2023

A series of **5 sessions** were conducted for parents who have their children enrolled in Early Childhood Intervention (ECI) therapies. The parents were trained on **Behavior Management techniques** by certified Behavior Therapists, motivated on the significance of early intervention by departmental heads and apprised on ECI policies by the team, to ensure consistent progress by the enrolled children.



Sensory Integration Workshop


