
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What is Down Syndrome?

Down syndrome is a genetic condition which occurs when an individual has a full or partial, extra copy of chromosome 21. This additional genetic material alters the course of physical and intellectual development. A few of the common physical traits of Down syndrome are low muscle tone, small stature, an upward slant to the eyes, and a single deep crease across the center of the palm – although each person with Down syndrome is a unique individual and may possess these characteristics to different degrees, or not at all. Down syndrome can be found in people of all ages, race and economic backgrounds.

About 1 out of every 700 babies born in the world has Down syndrome.



About KDSP

The Karachi Down Syndrome Program (KDSP), a non-profit organization, was launched in March 2014 by a group of concerned parents and passionate individuals who realized that a need for a platform for those with Down syndrome was evident since the support and resources available to them locally were very limited. KDSP was formed with the goal to advocate the value, acceptance and inclusion of people with Down syndrome living in Karachi and to provide them with the opportunity to lead independent and fulfilling lives.

Mission

The mission of KDSP is to be the foremost organization in Karachi for information, networking, and advocacy for and about Down syndrome, by people with Down syndrome and their families, educators, healthcare professional, and the community-at-large.

Vision

KDSP envisions a world in which all people with Down syndrome are accepted, included and are given the opportunity to enhance their quality of life, realize their life aspirations and become valued members of welcoming communities.

Areas of Service



Early Childhood Intervention

Providing speech-language therapy, occupational therapy and physical therapy to children with Down syndrome to help them achieve their developmental milestones timely



Education and Training

Providing children with Down syndrome access to mainstream education by inculcating school readiness and fostering inclusion at mainstream partner schools



Family Support

Providing informational, emotional and financial support to parents and caregivers of individuals with Down syndrome to help them raise an independent child



Healthcare

Facilitating access to subsidized cost, high quality healthcare services by partnering with leading healthcare organizations such as the Aga Khan University Hospital (AKUH)



Enrichment and Skills Development

Hosting vocational training and enrichment programs for social, physical and intellectual development and financial independence of individuals with Down syndrome



Awareness

Promoting inclusion of individuals with Down syndrome in society through campaigns, sensitization sessions, events and publications.



Children with Down syndrome experience delays in achieving their developmental milestones. Early Childhood Intervention enhances their chance at achieving key developmental milestones in a timely manner through speech-language therapy, occupational therapy and physical therapy. The therapy sessions are offered at KDSP by professionals with a breadth of experience and knowledge and run from Monday to Saturday, 9:00 am to 5:30 pm, for children aged 0-7 years.


Healthcare - Specialized and Quality Care

Children with Down syndrome have additional healthcare needs which require specialized medical attention and support which is not affordable for most families. KDSP facilitates access to high quality subsidized cost healthcare by partnering with leading healthcare organizations such as the Aga Khan University Hospital (AKUH) and The Indus Hospital (TIH). At AKUH, the Down Syndrome Clinic is a one stop health-care solution for individuals with Down syndrome with multiple qualified pediatric specialists with whom they can consult. AKUH also facilitates children with Down syndrome who require surgeries. Furthermore, KDSP runs Developmental Pediatrics Consulting Clinic for individuals with Down syndrome to create plans for their behavior, learning and overall development.

Children with Down syndrome thrive in mainstream schools however inclusive education in Pakistan is far from being a reality. KDSP paves the road to inclusive education through various programs including the Early Preschool Program – inculcating school readiness in toddlers with Down syndrome aged 1.5-3 years; the Inclusive Education Program – partnering with mainstream schools to foster inclusion of children with Down syndrome aged 2.5+ years; the Remedial Education Programs – teaching basic academic and life skills to children aged 8+ years and the Teacher Training Program – providing teachers, parents and allied professionals with the knowledge and practical skills required to work with children with Down syndrome in inclusive settings.

These Programs are divided into Living Skills such as Music and Movement, Yoga and Vegetable Planting and Vocational Skills which include Arts and Crafts and Block Printing to name a few.

KDSP's Family Support services aim to provide emotional, informational and financial support services for parents and caregivers to help them raise an independent child. These services include weekly Family Support Group sessions, Humrahi Program (parent peer support), Mindful Art Sessions for mothers and siblings, Yoga for mothers and Bi-Annual Feedback Sessions with families.
